

Charter for WEB.ZA

1) NAME OF SECOND LEVEL DOMAIN

WEB.ZA

2) INTENTION

WEB.ZA is an unrestricted second-level domain (SLD) that is intended for registration of names for any purpose.

3) CRITERIA FOR ACCEPTING REGISTRATIONS

a) Eligibility for registration

There are no eligibility requirements for registering a name in WEB.ZA.

b) No limit to the number of registrations

There is no limit to the number of WEB.ZA names that a Registrant may register. Names are available for registration on a first-come, first-served basis.

c) Protection of intellectual Property

By registering a name under WEB.ZA, the Registrant warrants that such a name does not infringe any intellectual property or other rights of any other party. The Registrant also indemnifies and holds ZADNA and the WEB.ZA Registry Operator harmless against any legal action that may arise as a result of the Registrant's holding and/or use of a WEB.ZA name.

4) REGISTRY SERVICE

ZADNA has appointed the ZA Central Registry (ZACR) to serve as the Registry Operator for WEB.ZA. ZACR's role includes the provision of registry services, including name servers, zone file maintenance, Whois services, security infrastructure, and interfaces and associated services to accredited registrars.

5) REGISTRAR SERVICE

All Registrars that have been duly accredited by ZACR or that are licensed or accredited by ZADNA are eligible to register names in WEB.ZA.

6) DOMAIN NAME FEES

ZADNA sets domain name fees for all the ZA second level domains (SLDs). Consequently, ZADNA will, from time to time, determine WEB.ZA domain name fees, which Registrars will pay to ZACR upon registration and renewal of registrations.

7) WEB.ZA POLICY

In addition to registration requirements stated in this Charter, Registrants and Registrars shall comply with:

- a) ZADNA's General Policies and Regulations;
- b) Specific policies that ZADNA may apply specifically to WEB.ZA; and
- c) Supplemental, operational policies of ZACR.

8) WEB.ZA DISPUTE RESOLUTION

All WEB.ZA Registrants, as a condition of registration, agree to voluntarily submit to the application of the ZA Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) Regulations (as promulgated by

the Minister of Communications in terms of section 69 of the Electronic Communications and Transactions Act 25 of 2002) for the resolution of disputes over WEB.ZA domain names.
